



PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This articulation agreement is made this 17th day of November 2008 by Northwest College and National American University, a division of DLORAH, Inc., a South Dakota Corporation. This agreement is to recognize and formalize a collaborative degree completion program offered by Northwest College and National American University.

Northwest College and National American University are accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and are members of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Northwest College offers associate degree programs on an academic semester system under authority granted by, among other authorities, the State of Wyoming. National American University offers baccalaureate degree programs on an academic quarter system under authority granted by, among other authorities, the State of South Dakota. It is recognized that both Northwest College and National American University have made appropriate provisions for: 1) periodic review of these academic programs and courses by their faculties, 2) the delivery of student support services, and 3) student access to required learning resources.

Whereas, National American University and Northwest College, institutions of higher education, are desirous of developing a relationship by which students can transfer credits earned at Northwest College to National American University with a minimum of delay and disruption in their educational process.

ARTICULATION

National American University agrees to admit all graduates of Northwest College associate degree programs into National American University's bachelor of science degree programs. National American University further agrees that these graduates will be able to transfer semester credit hours that have been successfully completed for associate degree programs at Northwest College.

Completion of National American University's bachelor of science degree programs will require the successful completion of the associate degree programs at Northwest College for transfer into National

American University. If the student has additional transferable credits, the minimum 54 credit hours for residency are required. A listing the specific National American University courses and their quarter hour equivalency plus the additional courses required for graduation are found in attachment A.


DURATION

The initial term of this Agreement will commence on the effective date indicated on page one of this Agreement. This agreement will automatically renew for one (1) year periods as long as the program requirements are the same for both National America University and Northwest College, or either party provides the other party with written notice of non-renewal not less than ninety (90) days prior to the end of the applicable annual anniversary date.

Upon termination of this Agreement in accordance with the foregoing section, National American University will continue to perform the duties and responsibilities set forth in this Agreement for any bachelor of science degree programs that have been commenced but not completed at the termination date.


