This is it. There are only a few more weeks left before you embark on your journey to a new and foreign place. Sometimes, one of the hardest things to do is to remember to pack everything and to make sure that nothing of

importance and value gets left behind. The following list is to help you pack and for you to think about things that may be useful at Northwest College. Keep in mind though; a lot of these items, such as clothes and electronics, can be purchased around the Powell area.

**Important documents**- These are the most essential documents to bring and to have with you. It would be best to obtain English translations of these documents and have them certified by a U.S. educational advising center or a U.S. Consulate or Embassy before traveling to the United States. Another good idea is to make copies of each document and keep the copies separate from the official document in case they get lost or stolen.

Movies, presentations, catalogues, and brochures about your country that can be used for
sharing with other students, your friendship family, the campus, and the surrounding
